

Core Subjects:

Links to theme

English

- Children will learn and perform The Very Hungry Caterpillar. (Using Talk for Writing actions.)
- Children will write their own version of The Hungry Caterpillar.
- Children will explain and record the life cycle of a butterfly.
- Children continue to read individually and in groups. Children participate in 4 x phonics sessions each week.

Mathematics linked to theme

- Children will sort creatures that fly into Venn diagrams.
- This term we focus on multiplication(2,5 &10), division and fractions.

Science

- Children to make and test paper aero planes.
- Children to observe, first hand, the life cycle of creatures that fly.
- Children continue to observe seasonal weather changes.

Personal Development

Spiritual

Children discuss their own religion and different religions around the world.

- Children use simple maps and aerial photographs to name and locate local landmarks.

Citizenship

- Children discuss holiday destinations and job roles at airports.

Art and Design and Design Technology

Art

- Children will create a hot air balloon collage, featuring local landmarks.

Design Technology

- Children to use different materials to design and create their own rocket ship or aeroplane. The BIG BUILD project.

Music, Languages and Physical Education

Music: Children will listen to music from around the world and name common instruments.
French: Children will learn the vocabulary for creatures that fly in French.
