

Core Subjects:

Links to theme

English

- Children will learn and perform the story Rosie's Walk. (Using Talk for Writing actions.)
- Children will write their own version of Rosie's Walk.
- Children will label and describe pictures.
- Children continue to read individually and in groups.
Children participate in 4 x phonics sessions each week.

Mathematics not linked to topic theme

- This term we focus on place value and addition and subtraction. Children will count forwards and backwards, compare and order numbers and develop mathematical language.

Science

- Children will observe, first hand, seasonal changes in their environment. (Autumn Focus)
- Children will participate in welly walks, every Friday, to support their scientific knowledge and understanding. (To include: Identifying and classifying trees and changes in weather.)

Spiritual

Children will discuss the story of creation. They will reflect on the wonders of nature, as they happen, by discussing changes in the seasons. (Links with weekly welly walk.)

Moral

Foundation Subjects

History, Geography and Citizenship

History

- Children will make and discuss personal time lines. (Changes in living memory)
- Children will place events in Picasso's life on a time line. (In chronological order.)
- Children will use common words and phrases relating to the passing of time.

Geography

- Children will name, describe and compare familiar places.
- Children will make simple maps and use aerial photographs to name and locate local landmarks.

Citizenship

- Children will learn about themselves and develop their role as members of the school community.

Art and Design and Design Technology

Art

- Children will create paintings and collages in the style of Picasso.

Design Technology

Children to use different materials to design and create their own pots and sculptures, inspired by the work of Picasso.
