<p>At the beginning of term the pupils will write recounts of their holidays. This term the children will be using the story of The Three Musicians, a book inspired by Pablo Picasso. They will use the language and structure to create their own stories.</p> <p>The grammar focuses this term will include: past and present tense verb endings; questions, statements and exclamations; commas in lists; capital letters for sentences and proper nouns.</p>	Moral	Art and Design Technology
	<p>In RE the children will be thinking about the Christian Creation story. They will be considering who made the world and how Christians show thanks to God for the Creation. The children will also think about the amazing world we live in.</p> <p>The children will be thinking about being thankful for Harvest.</p>	<p>History The children will be exploring what life was like when Picasso was alive and putting his works of art on a time line to develop understanding of chronological order.</p> <p>Geography Picasso lived in both Barcelona and Paris so the pupils will compare both locations, finding on them on the world map, identifying them in the continent of Europe and looking at aerial photographs to compare human and physical features.</p> <p>All term the pupils will look at and talk about Picasso's artwork. In the style of Picasso they will create collages and clay faces.</p>

<p>In maths the pupils will be developing their understanding of number. They will also look at 2D shapes in Picasso's work. They will be measuring length and temperature. They will also be comparing their measurements using the symbols on equality and inequality (<, = and >).</p>	<p>Our school value for the term will be 'friendship'. The pupils will be thinking about what it means to be a friend and solving problems that arise in friendships.</p>	<p>Music The children will be learning about the ukulele and how to play it.</p> <p>Languages In French we will be learning greetings.</p> <p>Physical Education The children will be attending Springboards this term to develop their gymnastics skills.</p>
Science	Cultural	Computing
<p>The children will be furthering their knowledge of plants by identifying plants and their structures. We will look at some of Picasso's artwork to help us with this.</p>	<p>There will be a Key Stage visit to Salisbury Cathedral, exploring what spirituality means to Christians.</p>	<p>Children will develop their e-safety awareness, use paint programmes to create pictures and use the internet to research Picasso. Children will learn to save their work.</p>
