Scientific and mathematical skills:

- Measure the length of your fingers.
- Create a graph showing the temperature each day.
- Record and compare the heights for everyone in your house. Can you order the heights?
- Make something to eat then draw or write out the precise instructions (an algorithm) for someone else to follow to recreate the dish.

Explore the world:

- Create a world jigsaw by cutting up a world map into continents and oceans.
- Find out which countries Roald Amundsen has been to and plot these on a map.
- Use a compass at home to find North, South, East and West. Name a place in each of these directions.

Values:

- Create a comic strip showing ways you can talk about your feelings respectfully. What if you were angry? How could you respectfully share your feelings?
- Write about something that makes you feel proud of yourself.
- Find out about a job that someone in your family does. Write about what it is they do and how they help others.
